Trauma-Informed Harm Reduction Certification

This self-paced training focuses on the core concepts of trauma-informed harm reduction as an approach that
emphasizes engaging directly with people who use drugs to prevent overdose and infectious disease
transmission, improve the physical, mental, and social wellbeing of those served, and offer low-threshold
options for accessing substance use disorder treatment and other health care services.

Rebound & Recovery: Opioid Prevention & Well-being for Teens Certification

An evidence-informed certification enhancing the resilience of middle and high-school-aged youth through
evidence-based strategies, including cognitive-behavioral skills. It equips them to manage emotions, thoughts,
and actions effectively, adopt healthier habits, and gain education on opioids, their misuse, and impact. The
curriculum teaches peer support, preparing them to provide support to peers & better cope with for stress and
mental health challenges. It's flexible, with options for quick one-hour lesson or seven one-hour lessons.

All courses, webinars, & certifications offer continuing education units.
