Development of Trainings, Webinars, & Courses



2,984 Trained community participants through webinars, self-paced online courses, & in-person trainings.



2,469 CEUs provided.

5 Online, interactive, self-paced courses were developed:

- 1. Overdose Prevention
- 2. Reducing the Stigma of Addiction
- 3. Trauma-Informed Harm Reduction Certification
- 4. Rebound & Recovery: Opioid Prevention and Wellbeing for Teens Certification

289 Participated in these courses & received CEUs.



15 Webinars were developed & hosted with live Q&A sessions.

1,228 Participants trained.
